TECHRADIUM, ADT IN PARTNERSHIP ON IRIS NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

HOUSTON – TechRadium, Inc., the Sugar Land, Texas-based communications company that supplies emergency and non-emergency alert systems, has announced an agreement with ADT Security Services to distribute TechRadium’s patented system IRIS, or Immediate Response Notification System, to educational institutions.
